SUMMER TERM HOME LEARNING PROJECT

Dear Parents / Carers of Year Two children,

The home learning project this half-term will take the form of an ongoing *Story Sack* project to be handed in to the class teacher by *18th May 2018*.

A *Story Sack* is a bag containing a picture book with supporting materials to stimulate reading activities. To bring the book to life, soft toys/ props relating to the items in the story, a non-fiction prop linked to the theme and a game based on the book are usually included. These can be made by the children using a variety of materials (we have a wide selection of *Story Sacks* in school and we will show the children examples.)

The books that we are suggesting are:

- ❖ *'Stick Man'* by Julia Donaldson,
- ❖ *'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'* by Judith Kerr or
- ❖ *'George and the Dragon'* by Chris Wormell,

This exciting project will be a good opportunity for the children to use high quality texts to promote a deeper love for stories and non-fiction.
