How to choose a school...

Visit and take your child with you

Talk to others, but advice can be out of date

Judge the ethos for yourself

Think about the journey

Think about your child's interests

Check how places were allocated before





Thinking about a selective school?

Only apply if your child has a good chance of succeeding

Alert your child to the number that are applying, so they don't feel decisions are personal

Remind them to be sensitive when talking to other children

Make sure your child has had support in preparing

Make sure you have a safe choice as well





How to apply...

Read Kingston's guidance booklet

Use the common application form

Make sure you use your up to date address

Make sure you apply on time

Apply for up to 6 schools

We can help you apply online (ask in the office)

Think very carefully about the order of your choices

Include any special information

Check if you need a supplementary form

Kingston will offer you the highest possible school

(Your child will only be offered a selective school if they have put it

high enough on the list)

1st March 2018 Outcome emails sent to parents (evening)

15th March Deadline for acceptances/refusals

26th April Deadline for receipt of appeals
