What is special about Christ Church New Malden Primary School?

Our split site (Infants on Lime Grove and Juniors on Elm Road) means that each site feels small and intimate with equipment and furniture tailor-made to the age of the children on the site. Who can apply?

All local families are welcome to apply, whether they are church going or not. In some years there is more pressure on places than others, so if you are interested in our school include us on the list, even if in previous years neighbours may not have been successful. There is also the option of being placed on the waiting list if a place is not immediately available. Do however, think carefully about the order you put schools in, as families have been disappointed in the past by putting safe choices above their preferred choice and therefore not being considered for their preferred choice.



How do you meet individual needs?



We are committed to ensure that every child achieves her/his full potential. We review their attainment and their progress every term and plan targeted support accordingly. There are additional staff who provide both support groups and extension groups in maths and English. There are also two pastoral mentors and we believe that it is vital that children feel safe and happy whatever the challenges facing them.

Which secondary schools do our children go to?

We value our partnership with parents and meet regularly to work together to enhance our provision. We also run our own before and after school child-care, Connect, to support working parents.

Which secondary schools do our children go to?

The majority will move onto Coombe Girls and Boys but they also transfer to selective schools such as Tiffin, and Sutton Grammar or to the private sector.
