Continuing key project for this academic year – School Playing Field

We have been able to make use of our playing field with the hire of a Portaloo. The fund has already paid for the foundations to be laid and we are currently reserving some of the funds already generosity given by parents and carers. We will continue to put aside some of the money you donate so, once we and the PTA raise the amount required, we will be able to go ahead with a permanent structure.

Infant playground

Some of the Governors Fund will be used to help pay, with the PTA, for the new adventure playground in the Infant playground. I am usually in school most Thursdays (with Open the Book) and I have been excited to see the project develop. The children who help us with the drama cannot wait to try it out and I am looking forward to see it completed too.

If you haven't got round to making a contribution this year I hope you won't mind this reminder. We recommend an annual contribution of £50.00. The governors are grateful that some people feel able to pay more and appreciate that other people's financial obligations are such that they are not able to commit to either the full amount or a one off payment of £50.
